Introducing the 100th Day Build A Sticker

The **100th Day Build A Sticker** can be used for a variety of lessons with your students:

Day-by-Day Mural

Here's a mural activity you can begin on the first day of school and keep going throughout the whole school year. The mural will help children build visual awareness and memory skills as they count the first 100 days of school (and beyond). Here's how to begin:

1. Cover a bulletin board or section of a wall with white or light brown craft paper.
2. Use a marker or bulletin board boarder to reserve a column to the right or left of your display. Use this space to list and number the name of each image you will add to the display each day.

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3. Before the first day of school, use fine-line markers to draw a small schoolhouse shape in the middle of the display. If you want, you can add a flag on top of the house labeled with the name of your school or your name (e.g., “Ms. Johnson’s Class”).
4. When children arrive on the first day, draw their attention to the display.
5. Tell them that each day you will add another image to the display and it will be up to them to figure out what’s been added.
6. Here are some suggestions for simple line-drawing images you can add to your display: cobblestone walkway to schoolhouse door (add stones one at a time), bushes, trees, birds, cats, clouds, stars, sun, moon, individual blades of grass, stick figures (add one part of each figure each day), etc.
7. Each day as children arrive to school, have them try and identify the new image you added to the mural. This activity is easy at first, but as the days pass and the display gets filled in, children will have to use keen observation and memory skills to locate the image you have added.
8. After students have correctly identified the new image for that day, add that day’s image to your number list until you reach 100.
9. On 100th Day, add a banner reading “Hooray for 100th Day” to your display!
10. On 100th Day, offer each student a **100th Day Build A Sticker**.
11. Invite each child to build his or her 100th Day Sticker and add it to the display.

Spell Well for 100th Day

Here’s a fun spelling game to play using your **100th Day Build A Stickers**.

1. Divide your class into several groups or teams so that there are three or four children in each one.
2. Distribute the **100th Day Build A Stickers** to children.
3. Offer one team at a time a word from a list of words you want children to spell.
4. Have a team member attempt to spell your target word.
5. If that child spells a word correctly, every child on his or her team gets to add one piece to his or her Sticker.
6. If the child spells a word incorrectly, the word is given to the next team.
7. Play continues with team members taking turns spelling words until every child has completed building his or her Sticker.
