

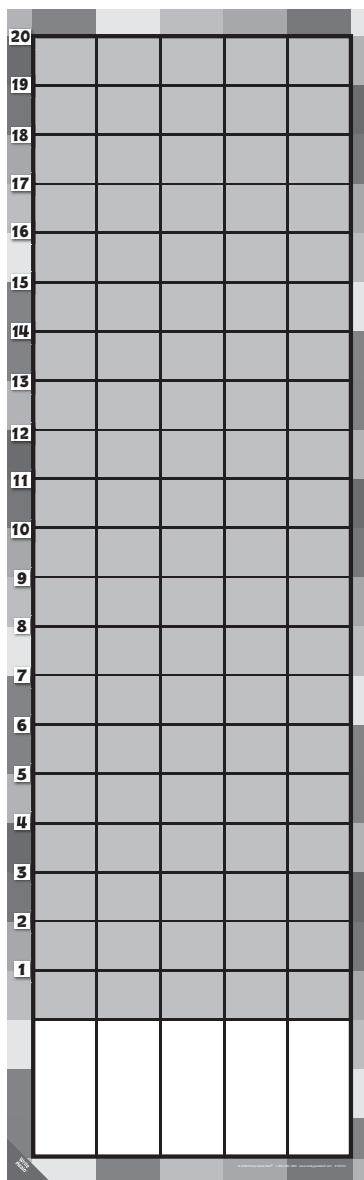
## Question of the Day Graphing Banner Set

Congratulations on your purchase of the Really Good Stuff® Question of the Day Graphing Banner Set! This set is designed to explore and organize concepts in your classroom. Graphing allows you to get to know your students better as well as allowing them to express their individuality.

### How to Use this Banner:



Use pushpins to hang the banner on a bulletin board or attach it to your chalkboard or easel with tape or magnets.

Begin by looking at the banner set together with your students. Explain that there will be a graphing question of the day written on the lines provided. In the activity guide, there are 200+ questions to choose from. You can select questions that align with a particular subject you are studying in your class or you can randomly choose a question to use on the graph. The selection of a graphing question can also be a designated classroom job for one of your students.

The numbers on the left side of the graph range from 1-20. This will help determine which choices selected are the most and the least. On the bottom of the graph

there are a maximum of five boxes for choices. These will change daily to match the possible answers to the question of the day. Questions will have a range of 2-5 answer choices.

Use this graph at a time of the day that fits into your schedule. Some suggestions would be:

- As students come into the classroom in the morning.
- Returning from recess.
- During independent work time. (You may need to structure when students work on the graph so that your entire class isn't trying to respond to the graph at the same time! Allow students to respond in groups of 3-4.)

It is important to model how the graph works. Write a graphing question of the day on the poster, for example, "What color do you like most?" In the bottom spaces provided, use a dry erase marker to write in the following choices: red, green, blue, yellow, purple. Students can reveal their choices in a variety of ways:

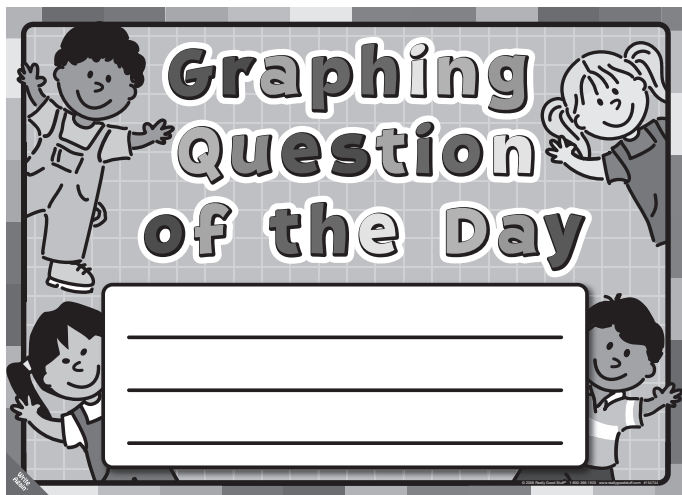
- Students can write their response on a Post-it® note and attach it above the selected choice.
- Students can use a dry erase marker to draw a smiley face in the box above their choice.
- Students can write their name in the box above their choice.
- Students can color in the appropriate box that matches their choice.
- Students can make an "X" above the appropriate box that matches their choice.

You may want to have students reveal their choices in one particular style before you move on to a different type of response. (e.g., students may draw a smiley face to provide their answer for the first week or two, before you have them respond on a sticky note.)

Most of the questions have multiple responses that you can use. You may use the choices provided for each question or may modify them to fit your students as you get to know them. There are a few questions that don't have definite answers to choose from. (e.g., What is your favorite TV show?) You need to elicit answers depending on your age group and interest level. Once the class has brainstormed possible choices, you can write them in the boxes at the bottom of the graph. You may want to have one of the choices be "other" or inform the students that they must select from the choices provided.

Feel free to use questions that may not be in this activity guide. You may discover questions that present themselves through a particular unit of study. Also, you can challenge your students to think of possible questions/answers to their own graphing question of the day. This would be especially good for students who need an extra challenge in your classroom.
