

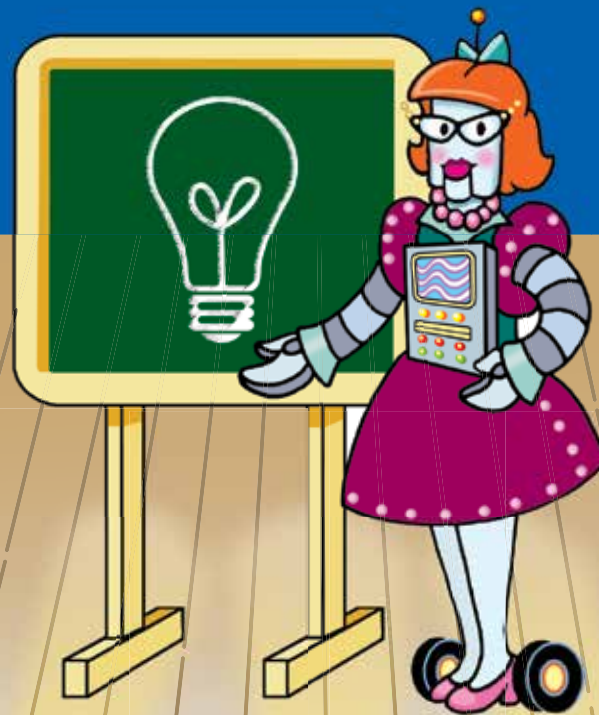

All: Come again, Ms. Botts!

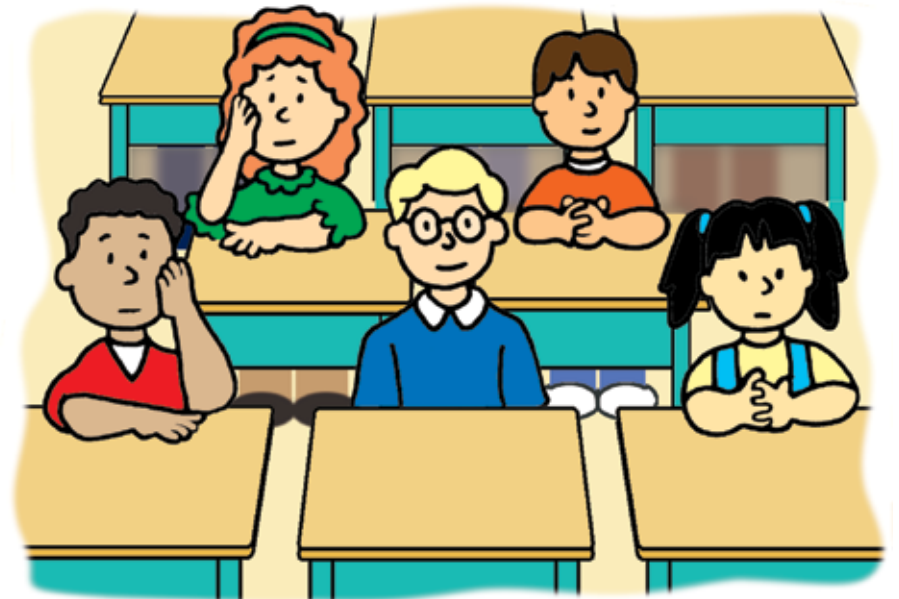


Good Morning, Ms. Botts!

Group 3: We feel a little sad. We know we will miss our teacher.

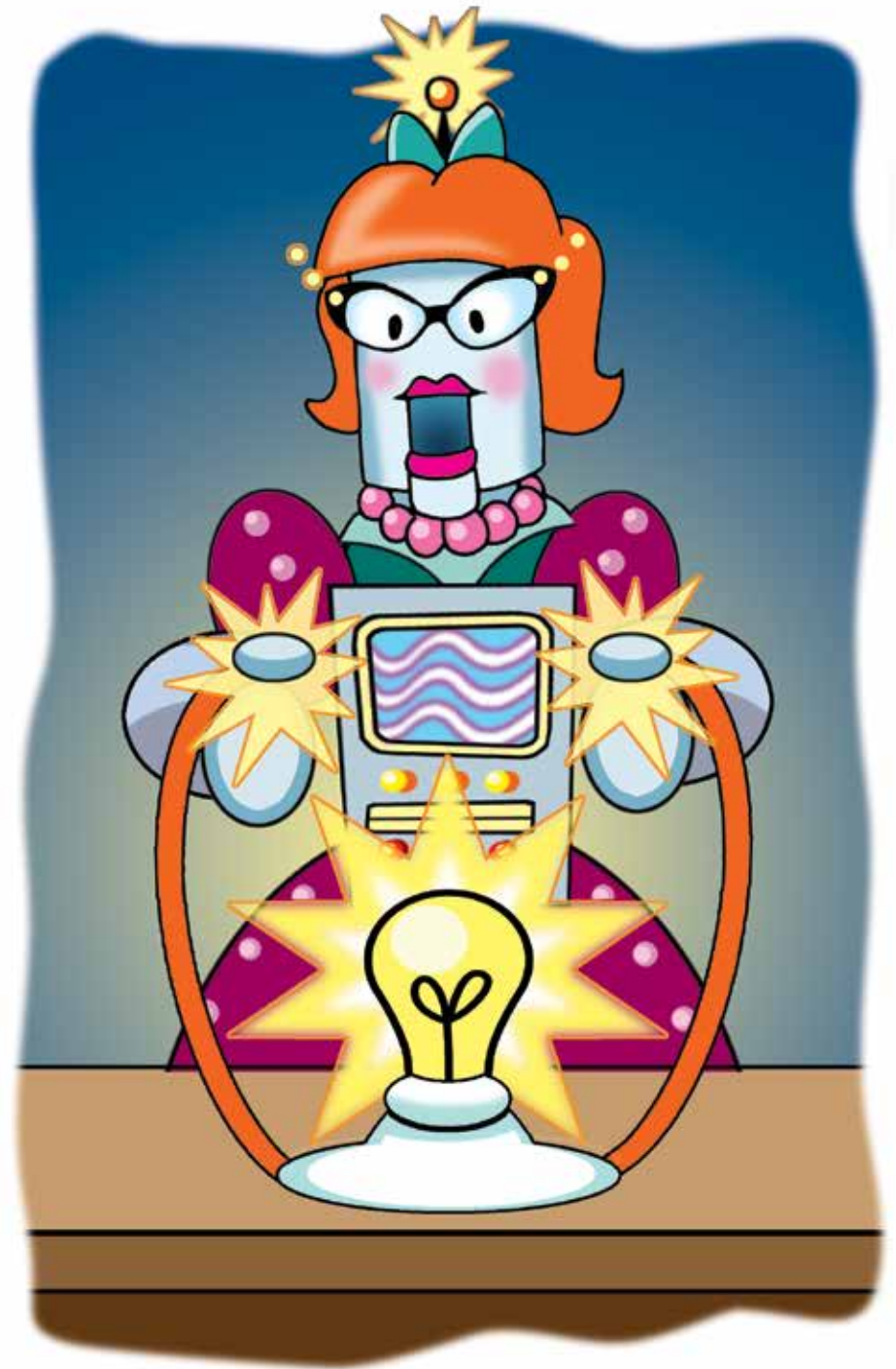


Group 1: Suddenly we hear a noise coming from the hallway.

All: The ball flies high in the sky, over our heads, and over a nearby mountain.

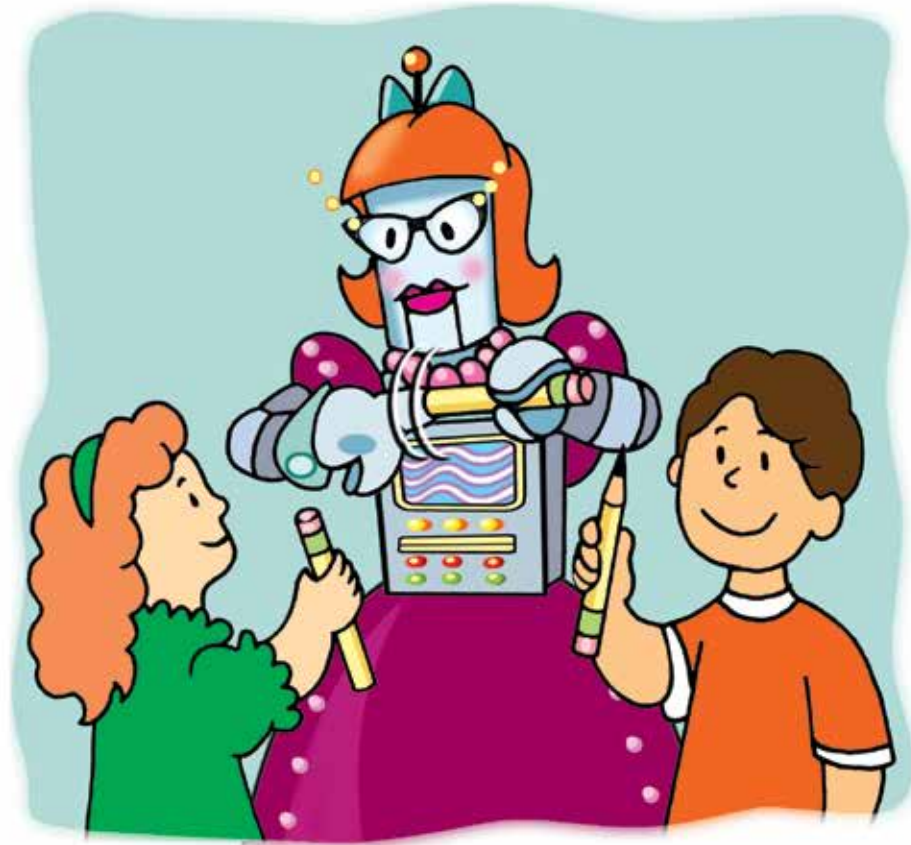


Group 1: Now it's time for our math quiz.
