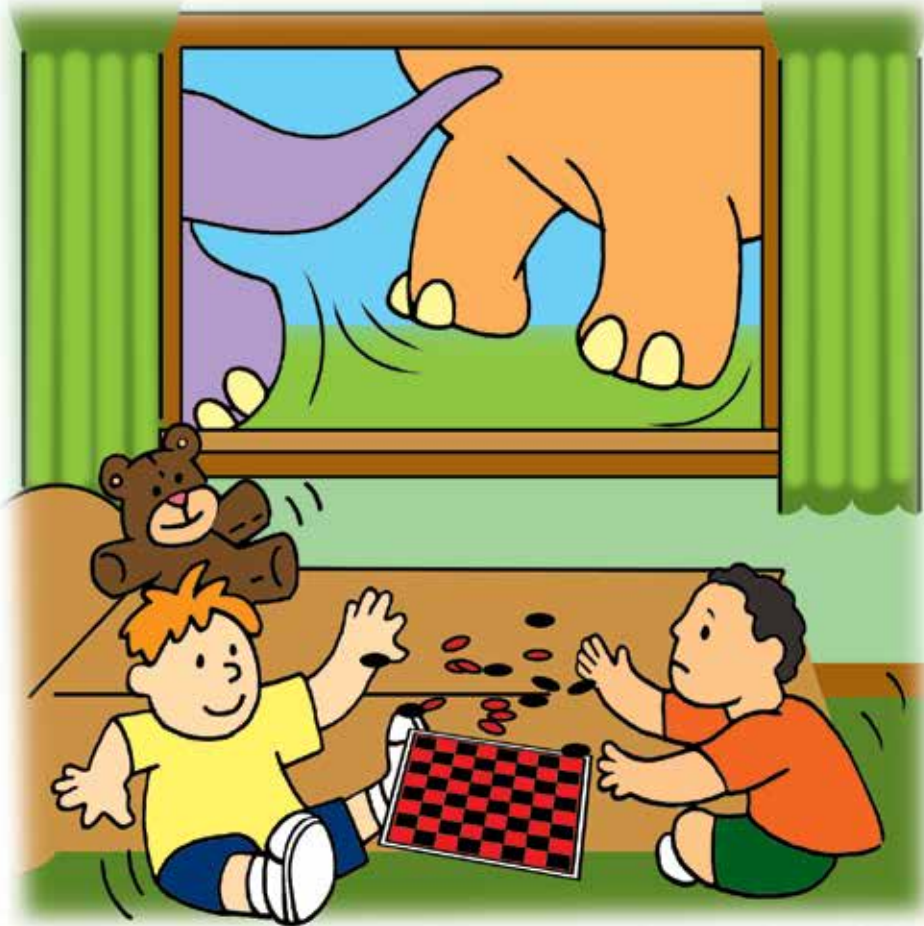

The Return of the Dinosaurs

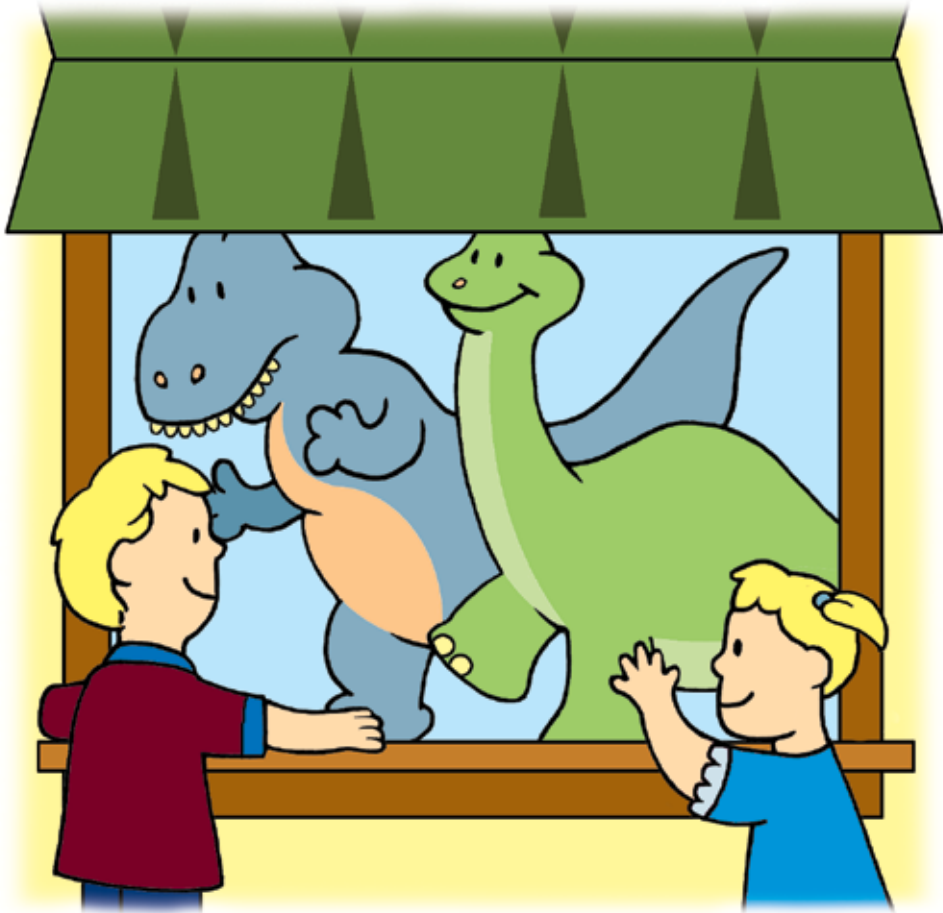


Group 1: One morning, we heard a loud sound outside our window.

All: There were dinosaurs walking down the street!



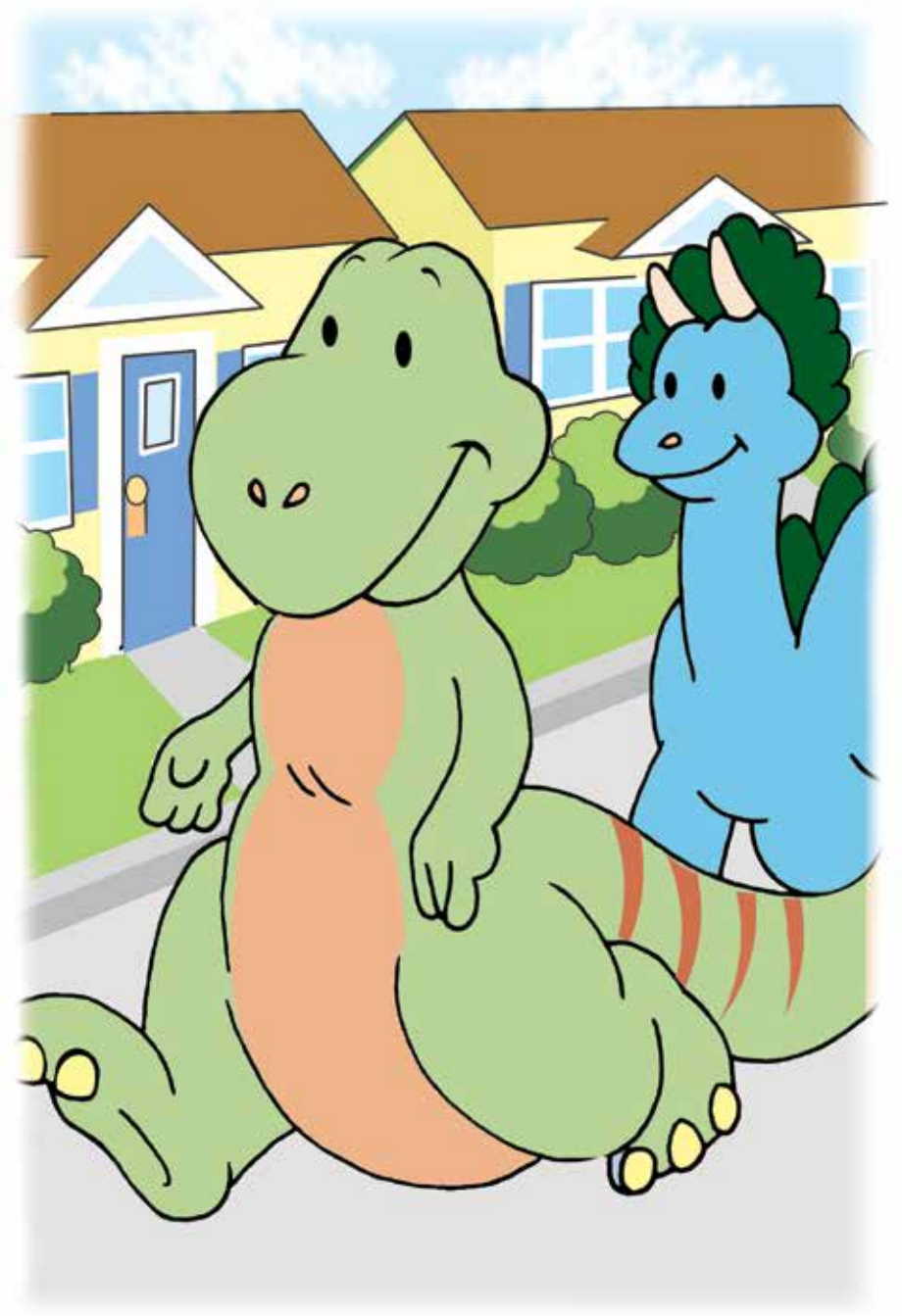
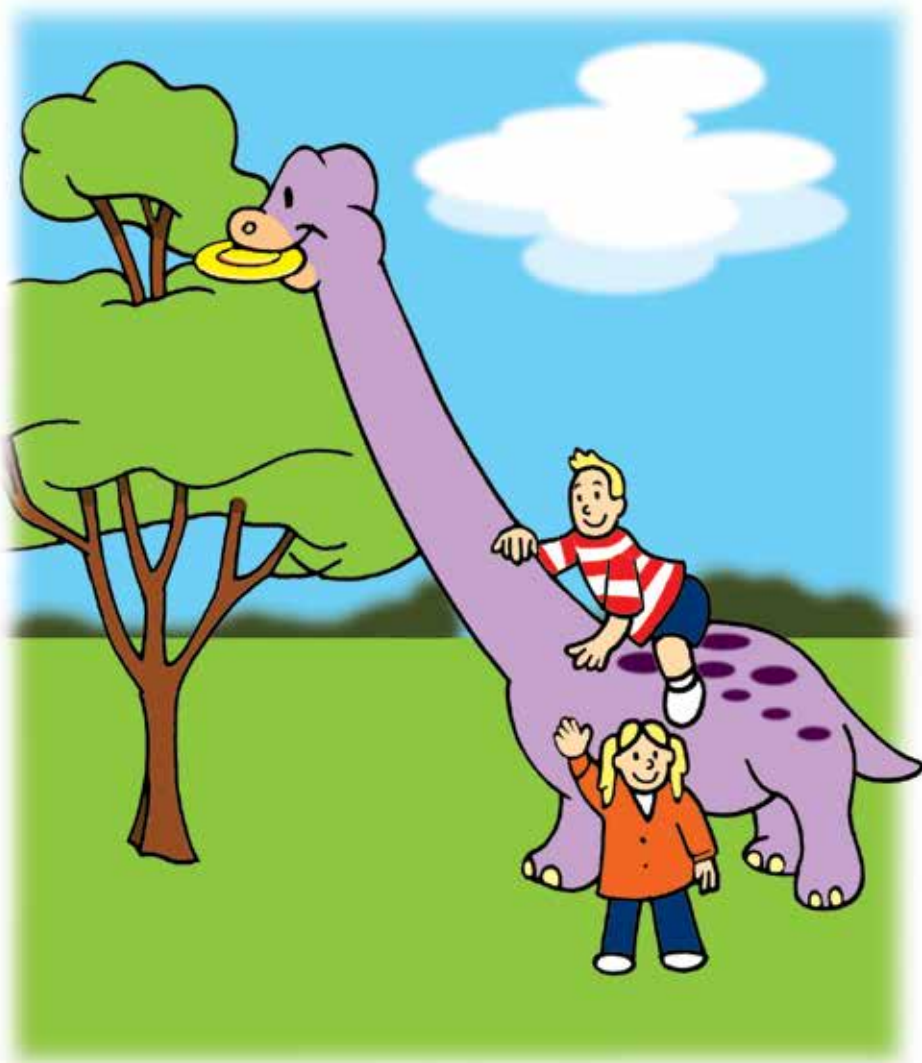
Group 1: Dinosaurs were our friends.

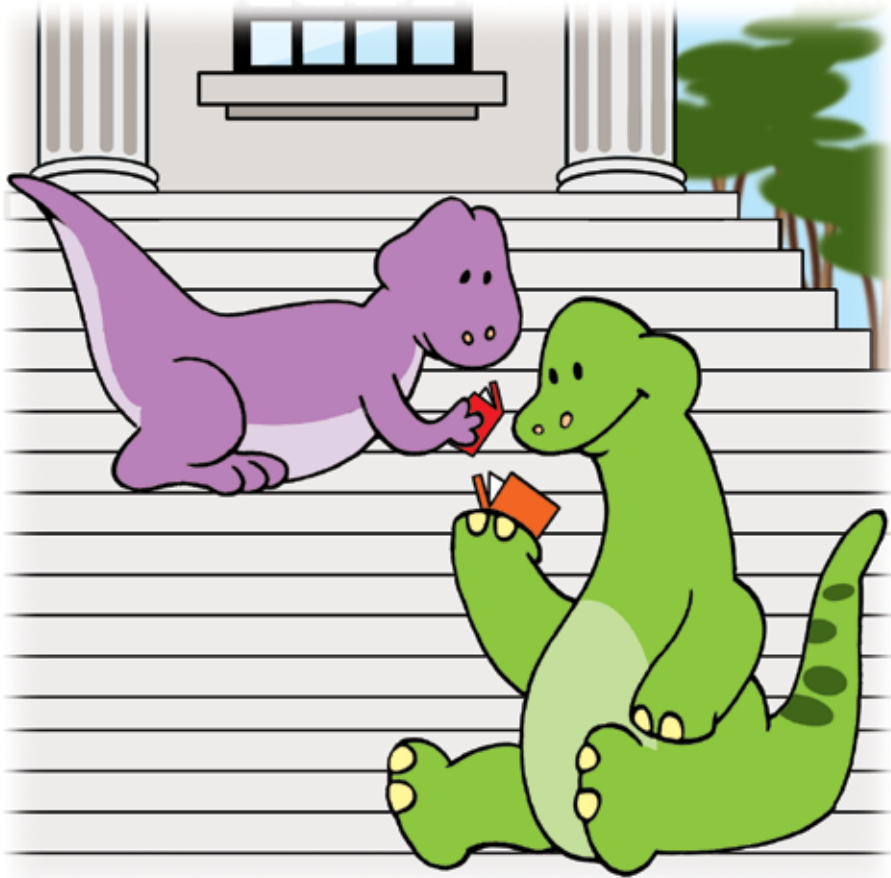
Group 2: At night, dinosaurs slept near our house. Sometimes, they snored!

Group 1: Some dinosaurs could reach high places. They could help us get where we wanted to go.



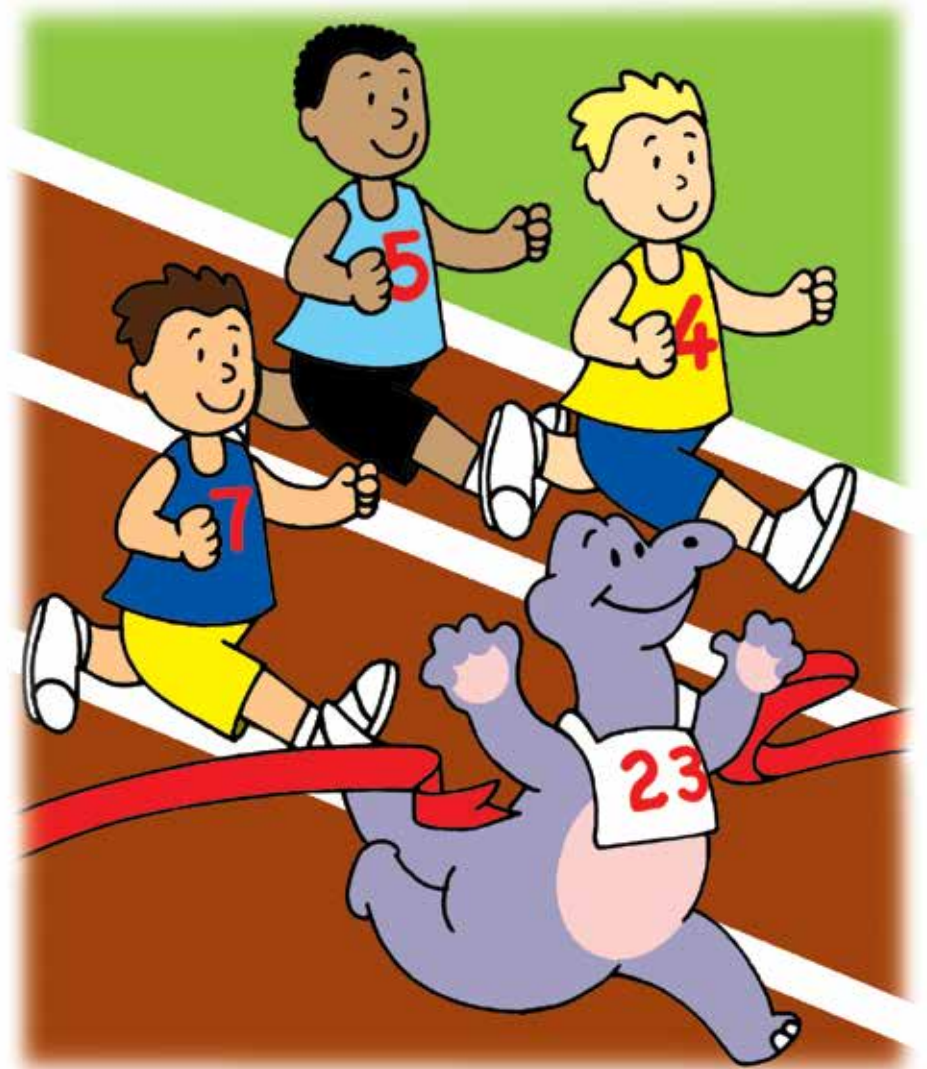


Group 1: Dinosaurs were in the town.

Group 3: Dinosaurs were in the air.

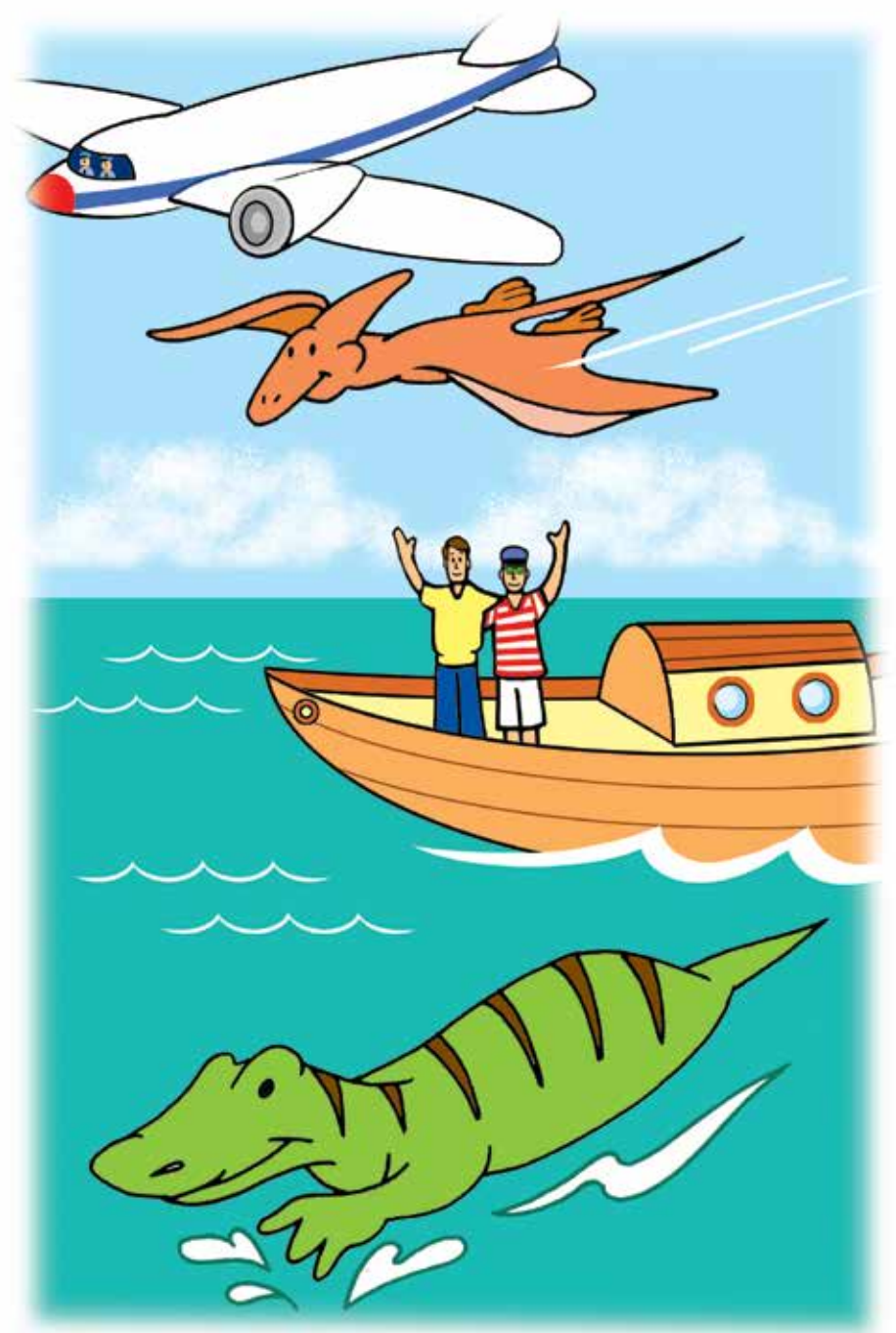
All: Dinosaurs were everywhere!
