Swing the club and hit that ball!

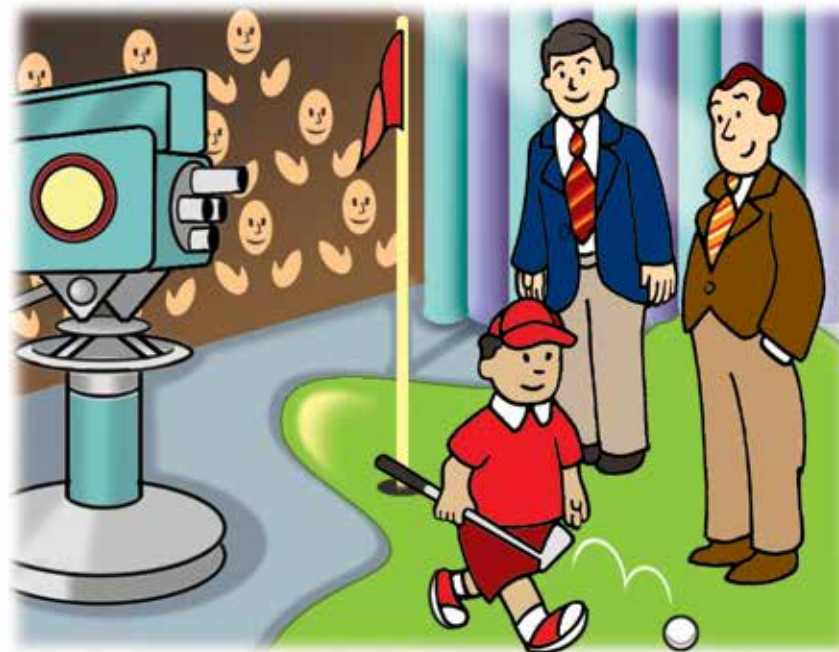


Group 1: When Tiger was only two years old, he played golf on a TV show.
