needed clothes, toys, and books.

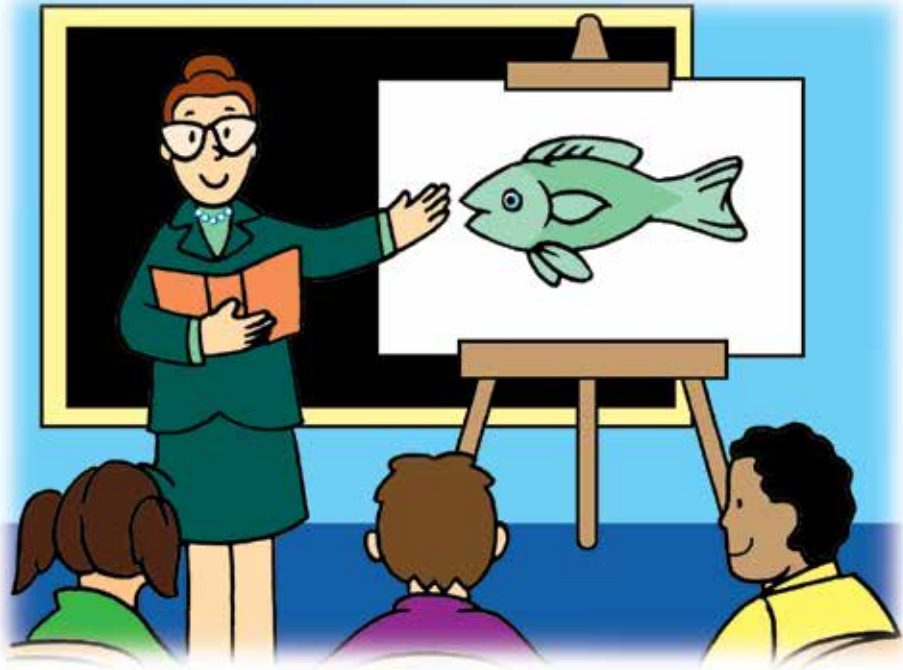
Group 3: We even packed our dog,

Group 1: We saw many different kinds of fish on the way to our new home.

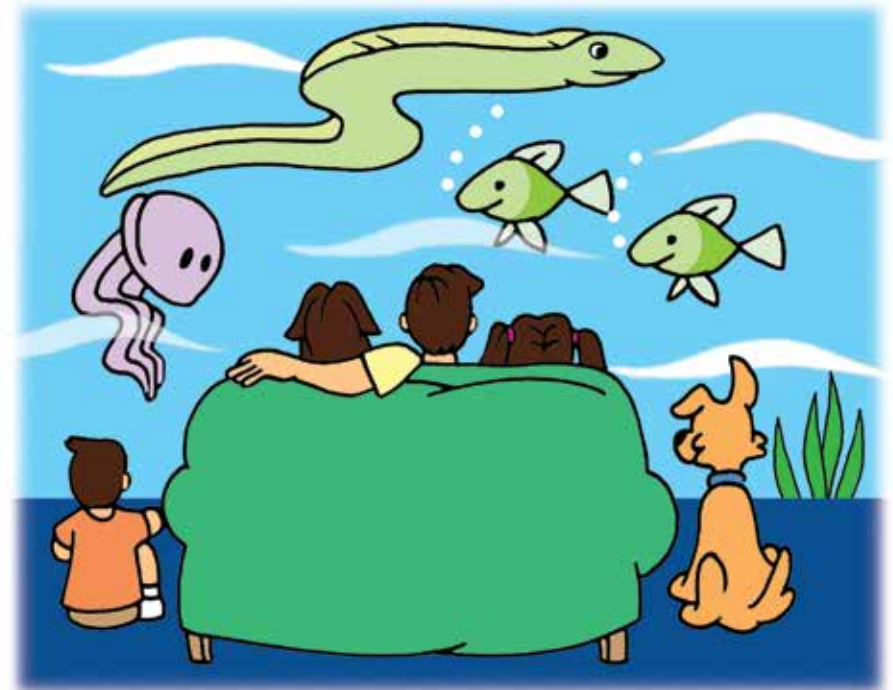
Group 2: There was an octopus with eight long arms.
