GOOD LUCK!

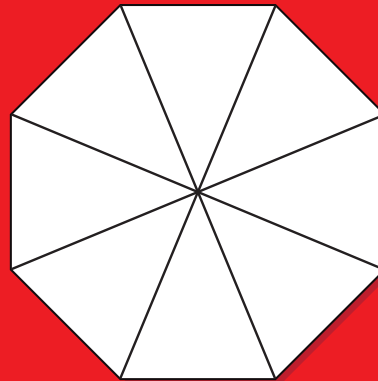
Red is a lucky color on Chinese New Year. A gift of something red is thought to bring good luck. Draw a picture of a red gift you might give.
