### Introducing the Addition-Subtraction Words Posters Set

Gather students together around chart paper or a whiteboard. Present them with several word problems using the following key words:

# Addition total join both sum all together plus combined increase add in all

# Subtraction how many more decrease left take away minus less than remain difference change subtract -er words, such as fewer, shorter, farther...

After several word problems, draw the outline of a large plus and minus symbol. Ask students which words in each word problem told them to add or subtract. Write the words inside the large plus symbol that tell you to add, and the words that tell you to subtract inside the large minus symbol.

After students have created a list of addition and subtraction words on their own, reveal the **Addition-Subtraction Words Posters Set**. Explain how these Posters will be displayed in the classroom as a resource to help them determine what operation to use when solving word problems. Encourage students to use the Posters when stuck on a word problem or when needing language to create a word problem.

Throughout the year, refer to the **Addition-Subtraction Words Posters Set** during math lessons to reinforce the terms.

### Addition-Subtraction Words Personal Poster Reproducible

Make enough copies of the Addition-Subtraction Words Personal Poster Reproducible for your class. Presented alongside the introduction lesson or administered as an assessment, have students write words that key them to use the operation of addition in the plus symbol and words that key them to use the operation of subtraction in the minus symbol. Have students share the words they wrote with the class. Then have them take the Addition-Subtraction Words Personal Poster Reproducible home to use as a homework resource.


## Addition and Subtraction Words Mini Desk Poster Reproducible
