

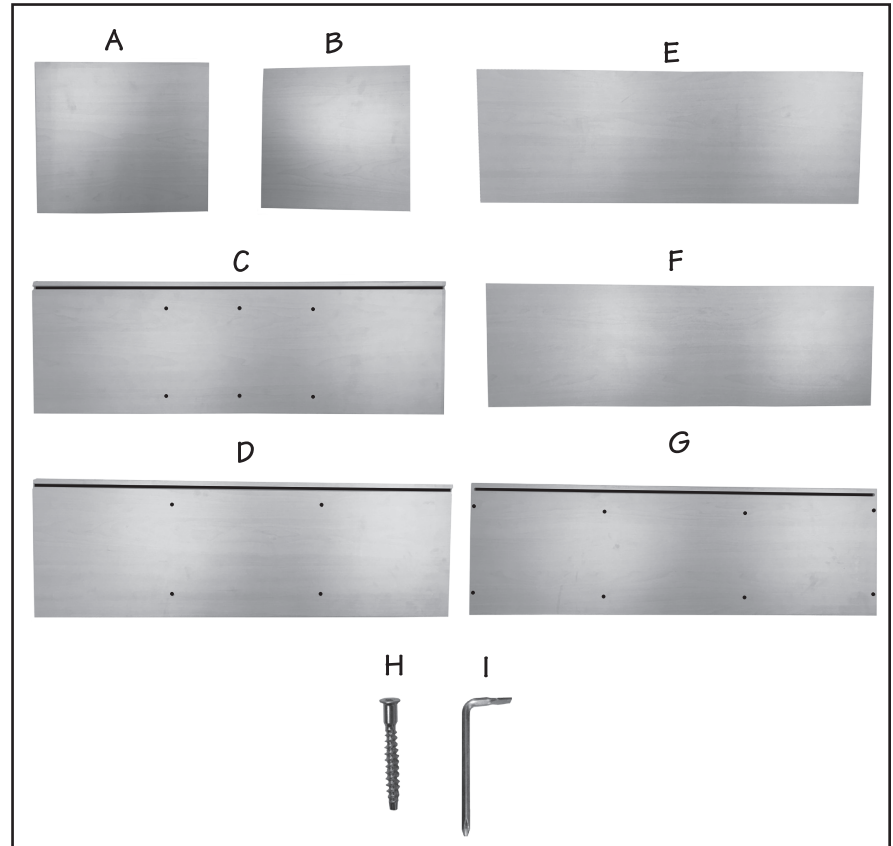
## Both-Way Shelf — Oak Assembly Instructions

Congratulations on your purchase of this **Both-Way Shelf — Oak**. (Adult assembly required.)

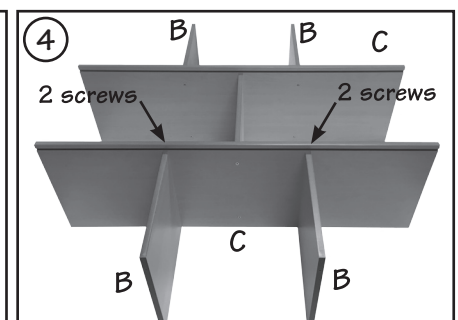
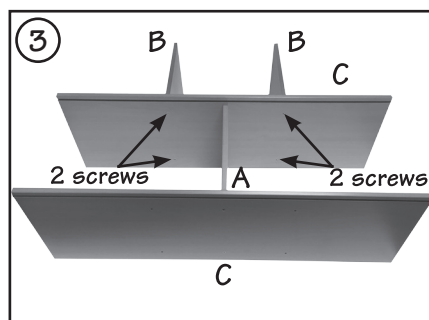
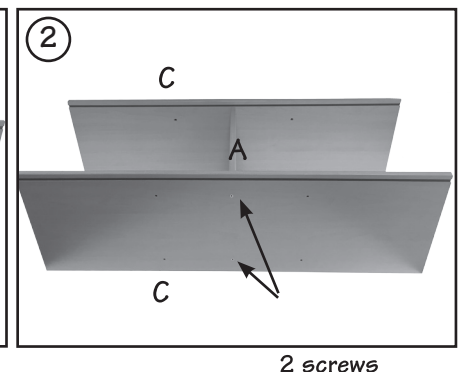
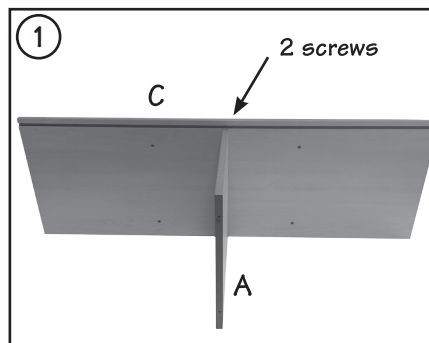
This Really Good Stuff® product includes:

- A — Center shelf
- B — 4 Shelves
- C — 2 Panels with 6 holes
- D — 2 Panels with 4 holes
- E — Center back panel
- F — 2 Outside back panels
- G — 2 Panels with 8 holes
- H — 36 Screws
- I — Assembly tool

You may also have received a spare piece of hardware.



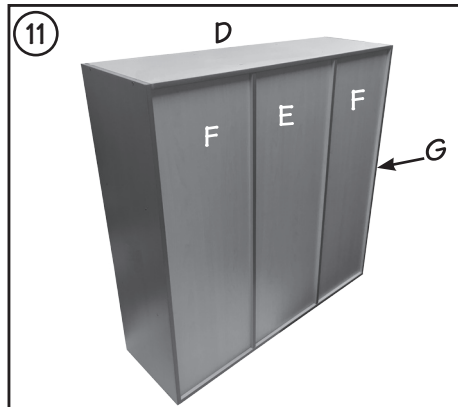
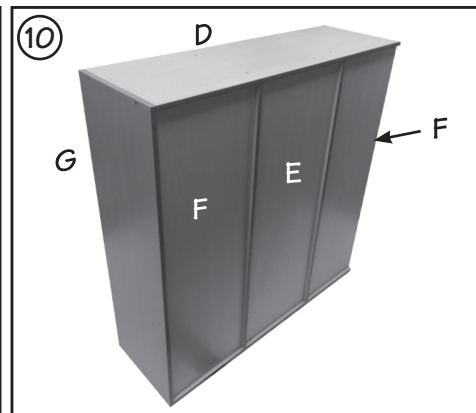
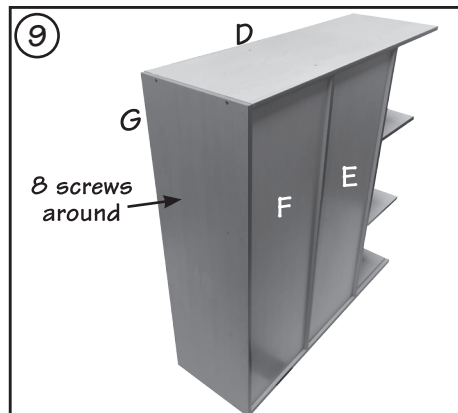
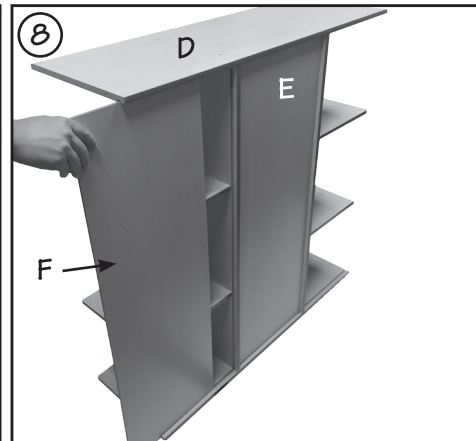
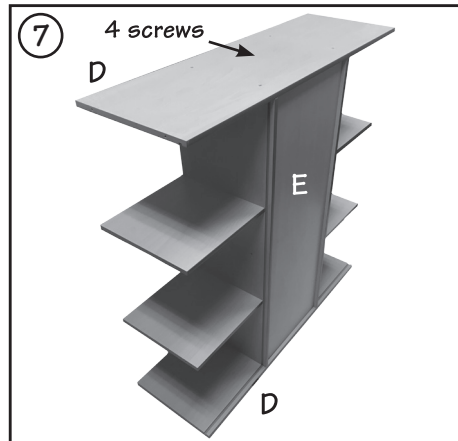
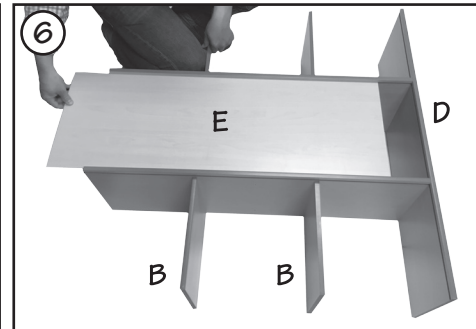
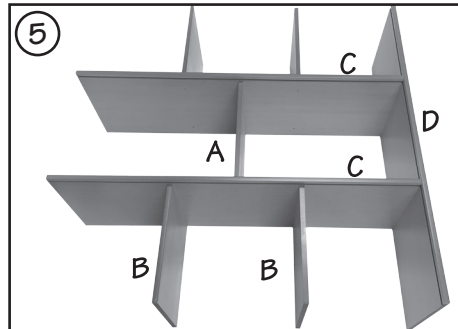
- ① Attach the center shelf **A** to the center holes of a panel **C** (with 6 holes) with 2 screws **H** through the top of the panel, making sure the channel on panel faces down.
- ② Attach the other panel **C** to the other end of center shelf **A** with 2 screws through the bottom of **C**, making sure the channel on the panel faces down.
- ③ Attach 2 shelves **B** to the top panel **C** with 2 screws each through the underside of panel **C**.
- ④ Attach the remaining 2 shelves **D** to the bottom panel **C** with 2 screws each through the top of the panel.

## Both-Way Shelf — Oak Assembly Instructions

- ⑤ Attach a panel **D** (with 4 holes) to the right side of the unit with 4 screws, making sure the channel on **D** aligns with the channels of the **C** panels.
- ⑥ Slide the center back panel **E** along the middle channels from the open left side.
- ⑦ Turn the unit to the right so that panel **D** is on the ground. Attach the other panel **D** to the top of the unit with 4 screws.
- ⑧ Slide an outside back panel **F** into channels of the left edge of the unit.
- ⑨ Attach a panel **G** (with 8 holes) to the left edge of the unit with 8 screws.
- ⑩ Slide the other outside back panel **F** into channels of the right edge of the unit.
- ⑪ Attach the other panel **G** to the right side of the unit with 8 screws.



**WARNING:** Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip-over. To help prevent tip-over: place heaviest items on bottom shelves. Never allow children to climb shelves. Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate, the risk of tip-over.
