


## Reading Area Two-Sided Bookcase Assembly Instructions


Attach the latch  $\mathbf{Q}$  horizontally to the right side panel  $\mathbf{A}$  with 2 short screws  $\mathbf{M}$ .

#### To assemble Bookcase 2:

Repeat steps 1-13 for Bookcase 2, using side panels  $\bf C$  and  $\bf D$  in place of panels  $\bf A$  and  $\bf B$ .

- Attach the latch strike plate  $\mathbf{Q}$  to the left side panel  $\mathbf{D}$  of Bookcase 2 using 2 short screws  $\mathbf{M}$ , making sure the hook side of the strike plate faces the front.
- Attach the 2 hinges K onto the right side panel C of Bookcase 2 with 3 short flathead screws N each, making sure the covered ends of the hinges are at the top.
- Place the bookcases back to back. Lift up Bookcase 2 (the unit with the hinges with no pintles) up and onto the pintles on the hinges of Bookcase 1.
- (19) Secure the bookcases together by hooking the loop edge of the latch over the hook side of the latch strike plate.





- 0 72 Medium screws
- P 8 Long screws (for rods)
- Q-1 Latch and strike plate



#### To assemble Bookcase 1:

- (1) Locate a shelf bottom **H** with **large** side holes and a shelf divider **I**. Attach the 2 pieces together with 3 medium screws **O** through the divider panel into the shelf bottom.
- 2 Turn the assembled piece to the left so that the shelf bottom **H** with the large hole is facing up and to the right. Locate another shelf bottom **H** with **small** side holes and attach it to the assembled unit with 3 medium screws **O** through the shelf divider **I**.
- Turn the assembled piece to the left again so that the shelf bottom **H** with the **large** hole is facing down and to the left. Locate another shelf divider **I** and attach it to the right side of the assembled unit (which is a shelf bottom **H** with the **small** hole) with 3 medium screws **O** through the shelf divider **I**.





## Reading Area Two-Sided Bookcase Assembly Instructions


- Flip the assembled piece over to the right so that that the shelf bottom **H** with the **large** hole is on the right. Attach another shelf bottom **H** with **large** side holes to the shelf divider **I** on the left side with 3 medium screws **O** through the shelf divider **I**.
- 5 Flip the unit over to the left. Attach a shelf divider I to the shelf bottom H with the large hole on the right with 3 medium screws 0 through the shelf divider I.
- 6 Flip the unit over to the left. Attach a shelf bottom **H** with the **small** holes to the shelf divider **I** on the left with 3 medium screws **O** through the shelf divider **I**.
- Deaving the unit in the same position, locate a back panel **F** and attach it to the shelf bottom **H** with the **large** hole on the right side with 3 medium screws **O**.
- 8 Flip the unit over so that the unit is upright with the back panel **F** at the back and facing forward. Locate the right side panel of Bookcase 1 **A** and insert 2 wood pegs **L** into the 2nd and 4th holes on the inside of **A**. Line up the wood pegs with the larger holes on the right side of the assembled unit.















## Reading Area Two-Sided Bookcase Assembly Instructions

- 9 Screw in 4 medium screws 0 from the outside of panel A: 2 screws along the right back edge and 2 screws in the holes toward the bottom.
- Locate 2 wood rods **E** and place them in the top and bottom holes on the inside of panel **A**. Secure the rods with 2 long screws **P** through the larger holes on the outside of panel **A**.
- Locate the left side panel of Bookcase 1 B and insert 2 wood pegs L into the 2nd and 4th holes on the inside of B. Locate a wood rod E and place into middle hole of the inside panel A on the right. While holding the rod in place, line up the hole for the rod on the inside of panel B and the wood pegs on B with the larger holes on the left side of the assembled unit and squeeze together.
- Locate 2 long screws **P** and screw into the largest holes on the the outside of panel **B** to secure the wood rods. Then screw in 4 medium screws **O** from the outside of panel **B**: 2 screws along the left back edge and 2 screws in the holes toward the bottom.
- Locate a front panel G and attach it to the front of the bookcase with 5 medium screws O.
- Attach the 2 hinges with pintles J onto the left side panel B with 3 short flathead screws N each, making sure the pintles point up.


