**K.3** Represent a number of objects with a written numeral 0-20 (with 0 representing a count of no objects).


Choose a couple of students to model playing **Fence the Puppies - Subitizing** for the class. Explain the object of game and how to play it to the volunteers. With the rest of the class gathered around, encourage the volunteers to play the game. Showing students the *Center Task Card*, explain that it will be in the center with the game if they need to be reminded of how to play.

**Center Task Card**

Post the *Center Task Card* at the numeracy center where students will be able to see it easily. Remind students to refer to the shaded section at the top of the Card to be sure that they have all the needed materials.

**Puppy Match Reproducible**

Copy and distribute the *Puppy Match Reproducible* for everyone to use as practice, or use it as a follow-up for students who have completed the center. Explain to students that they are to match the number on each puppy's collar on the left side to the correct number of objects on the right side, using their subitizing skills.
