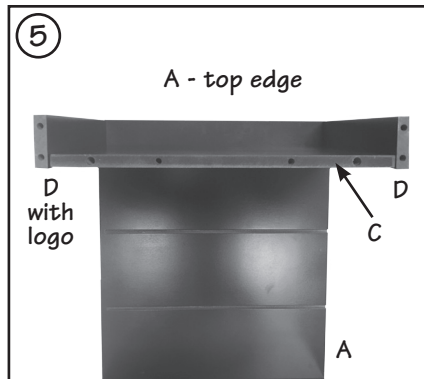
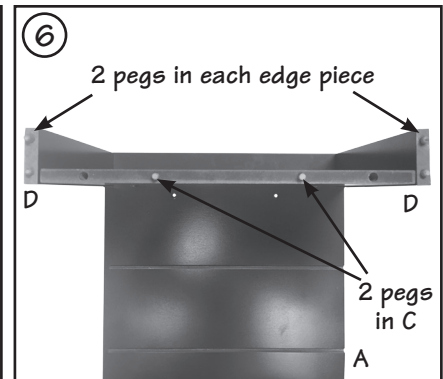


## Multi-Use Rolling Organizer with 6 Shelves Assembly Instructions

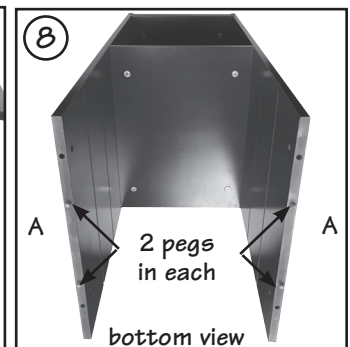
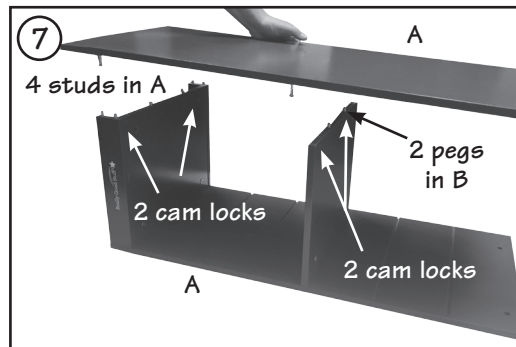
- ⑤ Insert 2 wooden pegs **J** into the top right holes of the side panel. Attach the remaining tray edge piece **D** to the top right side.



- ⑥ Insert 2 wooden pegs **J** into the holes of each tray edge piece **D** and 2 into the innermost holes of the top shelf **C**.

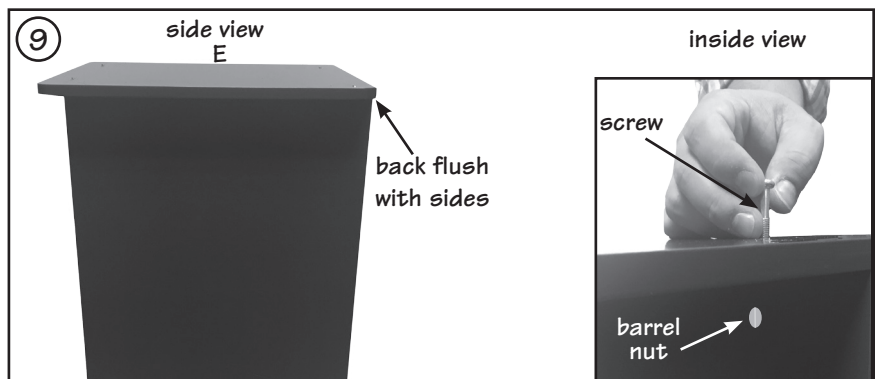


- ⑦ Insert 2 wooden pegs **J** into the innermost holes of the middle shelf **B**. Locate the other side panel **A** and screw in 4 cam lock studs **M** into the threaded holes at the top and middle and then attach to the rack by lining up the holes with the studs and pegs. Then insert 2 cam locks **L** each into the bottom holes of the top and middle shelves and turn to secure.



- ⑧ Turn the unit upside down and insert 4 wood pegs into the inner holes of each side panel **A**.

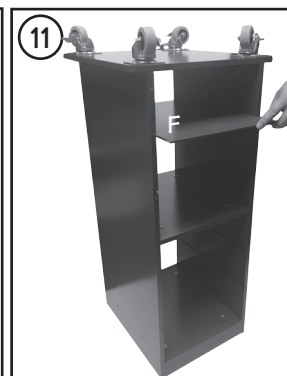
- ⑨ With the side of the bottom panel **E** that has the 16 predrilled holes for the wheels facing up, line up the holes on the bottom panel **E** with the wood pegs, making sure the back edge is flush with the sides. Install 4 barrel nuts to the top inside holes of each side, making sure the groove is going straight up and down into the interior hole. Install a long screw through the bottom panel and turn until secured.



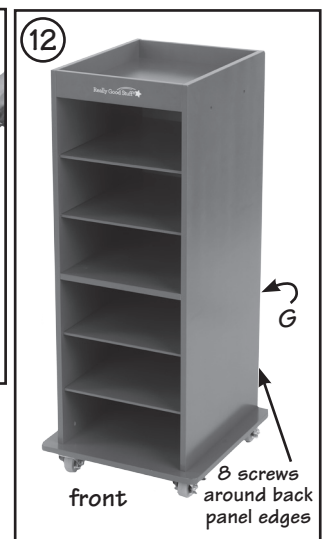
- ⑩ Attach the 4 wheels **H** to the bottom with 4 small screws **K** each.



- ⑪ Slide in the 4 thin shelves **F** through the channel slots.



- ⑫ Turn unit upright. Line up the holes in the back panel **G** with the predrilled holes on the back of the rack and attach with the 8 large screws **I**.



- Place heaviest items on bottom of cabinet.
- Never allow children to climb or hang on doors or shelves.

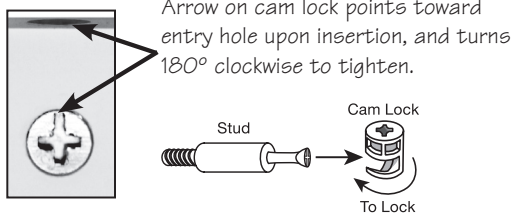

- A – 2 Side panels
- B – Middle shelf
- C – Top shelf
- D – 2 Tray edge pieces (one with logo)
- E – Bottom panel
- F – 4 Thin shelves
- G – Back panel
- H – 4 Wheels
- I – 8 Large screws
- J – 20 Wooden pegs
- K – 16 Small screws (for wheels)
- L – 8 Cam locks
- M – 8 Cam lock studs
- N – 8 Barrel nuts
- O – 8 Bolts
- P – Assembly tool

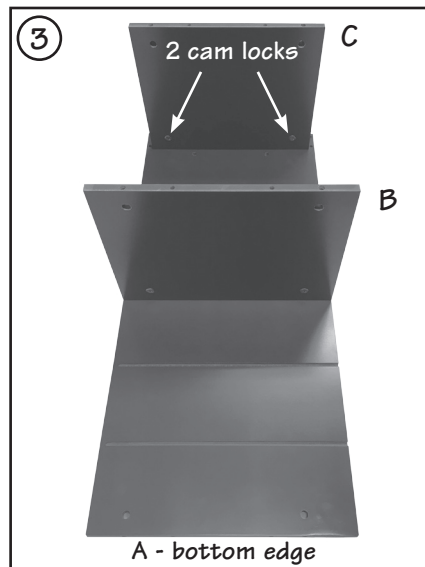
You may also have received a spare part of each piece of hardware.



- ① Locate a side panel **A** and screw in 4 cam lock studs **M** into the threaded holes at the top and middle and 4 wooden pegs **J** at the top middle center and top bottom holes.

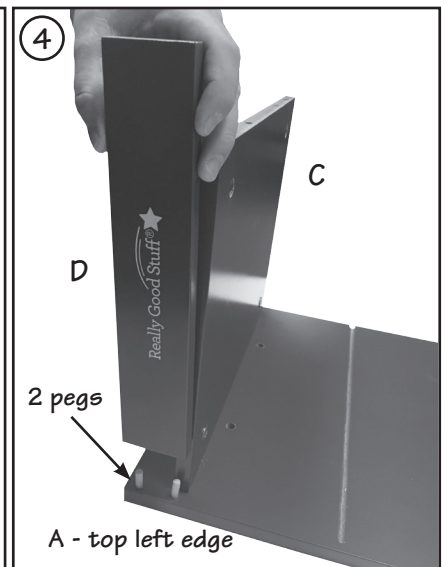


- ② Align the holes of the middle shelf **B** to the studs and pegs in the middle the side panel **A**, making sure the holes on the middle shelf are facing down. Insert 2 cam locks **L** in the 2 bottom holes and turn to secure.



- ③ Align the holes of the middle shelf **C** to the studs and pegs in the middle the side panel **A**, making sure the holes on the middle shelf are facing down. Insert 2 cam locks **L** in the 2 bottom holes and turn to secure.

- ④ Insert 2 wooden pegs **J** into the top left holes of the side panel. Attach the tray edge piece **D** with the logo to the top left side.
