

Word Building Sliders

Word Families

Object:

Students practice building words using common phonograms.

Each slider provides practice building four words with the same phonogram. Sliders are color-coded in five vowel groups. Demonstrate using the slider with a common phonogram, such as *ap*, before having the student practice independently.

Directions:

1. Read the phonogram.
2. Move the sliding beginning sound card to line up one of the beginning sounds with the phonogram.
3. Read the word. Think about what it means.
4. Find the picture that matches the word you have built. Move the sliding picture card to line up that picture with the word.
5. Turn over the slider to check your work. If the two shapes in the windows on the back are a match (circles, squares, diamonds, or stars), your picture-word match is correct.
6. Continue moving the cards until you have correctly built all four words and matched them with their pictures.
7. Using other sliders, continue building words, matching, and checking until time is up.

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
