

## **Object:**

Students practice building words using common blends and digraphs.

Each slider provides practice building four words with the same blend or digraph. Sliders are color-coded in five blend or digraph groupings: I-blends (aqua), r-blends (lavender), s-blends (green), digraphs (gray), and miscellaneous (brown). Demonstrate using a slider with a common blend, such as sl, before having the student practice independently.

## **Directions:**

- 1. Read the blend or digraph.
- 2. Move the sliding phonogram card to line up one of the phonograms with the blend or digraph.
- 3. Read the word. Think about what it means.
- 4. Find the picture that matches the word you have built. Move the sliding picture card to line up that picture with the word.
- 5. Turn over the slider to check your work. If the two shapes in the windows on the back are a match (circles, squares, diamonds, or stars), your picture-word match is correct.
- 6. Continue moving the cards until you have correctly built all four words and matched them with their pictures.
- 7. Using other sliders, continue building words, matching, and checking until time is up.
