


### Rhyme Maze

This is a simple rhyming maze that students can complete together or in pairs, taking turns. There is only one correct rhyming path through the maze that leads to a star. You can only move to a box that has one side touching (no diagonal moves).

Materials: 1 Rhyme Maze Mat, 1 Colored Set of Chips

# **Directions:**

- 1. Start in the box that says "Start here." and read the instructions aloud.
- 2. Place a chip over the first picture that matches the word family in the Start Box.
- 3. To move forward, name the pictures in the boxes while directly touching each one with your chip. If one of the pictures rhymes with the target word, cover it with a chip.
- 4. Continue covering the rhyming pictures as you make your way to the star. If you move to a box that does not lead to another rhyming word, you must go back until you find the correct path.
- 5. Once you complete the maze, name each picture again to hear the rhyming words.
- 6. Turn over the mat to check the answers.



# Partner Maze

Rules for this game are similar to the Rhyme Maze; however, this maze is for two players who make their own way to two different stars.

Materials: 1 Partner Maze Mat, 2 Colored Sets of Chips

### **Directions:**

- 1. Players both start in the same Start box and read the instructions.
- 2. Player 1 names the pictures in the surrounding boxes, identifies one with the target word family and places his or her chip over it.
- 3. Player 2 goes next and places his or her chip over a different picture (with the same word family).
- 4. Player 1 continues by finding a rhyming picture in a box that is touching his or her first selection.
- 5. Player 2 does the same. If a player moves to a box that does not lead to another rhyming picture, he or she must go back to the previous box and the turn is over.
- 6. Players take turns until they each reach their own star. The first player who reaches a star is the winner.
- 7. Players turn over the mat to check the answers and name the rhyming pictures.

# **Rhyme Hunt**

This is a rhyme hunt activity that students can use on their own or with a partner. If working in partners, provide two colored sets of chips and two different colored markers.

Materials: 1 Rhyme Hunt Mat, 1 or 2 Colored Sets of Chips, Dry Erase Marker

## **Directions:**

- 1. Read the instructions at the top and name the target picture.
- 2. Name a picture below. If it rhymes with the target picture, cover it with a chip or circle it and write its name on the first line.
- 3. Name another picture. Cover it with a chip or circle it and then write its name on the second line if it rhymes with the previous pictures.
- 4. Continue until all the rhyming pictures are found.
- 5. Turn over the mat to check the answers.

If playing in partners, take turns.
