## Letter Sound Sliders



## **Object:**

Students practice identifying beginning, middle, and ending letter sounds.

Each slider provides practice identifying four different letter sounds. Sliders are color–coded in three different groupings: beginning sound identification (red), middle sound identification (yellow), and ending sound identification (blue). Demonstrate using a slider in each color before having students practice independently.

## **Directions:**

- 1. Name each letter and say its sound.
- Find the picture that matches the letter sound you are working on.
  Move the sliding picture card to line up with the correct answer.
- 3. Turn over the slider to check your work. If the two shapes in the windows on the back are a match (circles, squares, diamonds, or stars), your answer is correct.
- 4. Continue moving the cards until you have correctly matched all four letter sounds with their pictures.
- 5. Using other sliders, continue matching letter sounds and pictures, and checking until time is up.
