

Letter Sound Sliders

Beginning, Middle, and Ending Sounds

Object:

Students practice identifying beginning, middle, and ending letter sounds.

Each slider provides practice identifying four different letter sounds. Sliders are color-coded in three different groupings: beginning sound identification (red), middle sound identification (yellow), and ending sound identification (blue). Demonstrate using a slider in each color before having students practice independently.

Directions:

1. Name each letter and say its sound.
2. Find the picture that matches the letter sound you are working on. Move the sliding picture card to line up with the correct answer.
3. Turn over the slider to check your work. If the two shapes in the windows on the back are a match (circles, squares, diamonds, or stars), your answer is correct.
4. Continue moving the cards until you have correctly matched all four letter sounds with their pictures.
5. Using other sliders, continue matching letter sounds and pictures, and checking until time is up.

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
