FLASHLIGHT SEARCH Activity

Letter Identification

CONTENTS:

10 Sleeves

5 Wands

10 Letter Identification Cards



This Flashlight Search Activity $^{\text{TM}}$ - Letter Identification is designed for up to five students to use at one time. Provide each student with I wand, I sleeve, I letter identification card, and a dry erase marker (not included). The cards and sleeves have a matching symbol in the bottom right-hand corner so that your students will know which letter identification card to use with each sleeve.

HOW TO USE:

- I. Students slide their wands into the sleeves and use the wands as "flashlights" to search for the letters on their cards.
- 2. Decide which side of the cards your students will be using to keep track of the letters as they find them. One side of each letter identification card features 10 letters with a box next to each one. Students use the boxes to check off each letter as they find and read it aloud. The other side of each card lists the letters and has lines for students to write each one as they find it.
- 3. Once students find all of the letters on their cards, they can take a different card, find the matching sleeve, and repeat until they have spotted all of the letters or until the allotted amount of time for the activity runs out.

ADDITIONAL USES:

- Challenge students to write the uppercase version of each letter that they find on a separate piece of paper or in their journals.
- Have students draw a picture of something that starts with each letter that they find on the sleeves.
- · Pair with a timer and see how quickly students can complete one card.
- Students can use the reproducible on the back of this instruction card to practice writing their letters.
