### How to Play:

- 1. All players:
  - Sit so that you can all see the "MOO-ve" Mobile Money Exchange Game Board.
  - Take a "MOO-ve" Mobile Order Work Mat.
  - Place the "MOO-ve" Mobile Order Cards on the Game Board.
  - Decide who goes first.
  - Start with \$30.00.
- 2. Player 1:
  - Take an Order Card.
  - Use the information on the Order Card to fill out the Order Work Mat.
  - Calculate the total for each item.
  - Calculate the subtotal for the entire order.
  - The next player checks your answer using the answer key on the back of that Order Card.
  - If your answer is correct, subtract a \$1.00 off "coupon" to calculate your FINAL TOTAL.
  - Subtract the FINAL TOTAL amount from your \$30.00 beginning amount.
  - The next player checks that balance using the calculator.
  - Write that correct balance on the top line as the beginning balance for the next round.
- 3. Player 2:
  - Repeat Step 2.
- 4. All players:
  - Continue playing until you have completed four rounds.
- 5. The player with the most money in his or her balance at the end of Round 4 wins.

Before introducing the "MOO-ve" Mobile Money Exchange,

Collect a calculator and dry erase marker for each player. Choose a group of students to play "MOO-ve" Mobile Money Exchange with you for the class. Explain the object of the game and how to play to the volunteers. With the rest of the class gathered around, encourage the volunteers to play the game. Showing students the Task Card, indicate that it will be in the center with the game if they need to be reminded of how to play.

### Task Card

Post the Task Card at the numeracy center where students will be able to see it easily. Remind students to refer to the shaded section at the top of the Card to be sure that they have all the needed materials.


