Easily differentiate practice: begin with the simplest set (pink) of ice cream cones, and read increasingly longer sentences in the blue, purple, and green sets. The pictures on the backs serve two purposes: to provide prereading support for acquiring the gist of the sentence and for postreading self-checks.
