Use the green cards for beginning blend and digraph sounds, the purple cards for short vowel word endings, and the orange cards for long vowel word endings.

### Managing the Blends & Digraphs Desktop Pocket Chart Card Set

Before using the **Blends & Digraphs Desktop Pocket Chart Card Set**, make copies of this Really Good Stuff® Instructional Guide and file the pages for future use. Or, download another copy of it from our website at [reallygoodstuff.com](http://reallygoodstuff.com).

Store the Photo Cards in numerical order and the Letter Cards in alphabetical order in the bag that's included. Choose the Letter and Photo Cards that you'll be using in the demonstration or activity ahead of time. Make copies of the included list of Photo Cards to use for data collection as a progress monitoring tool and as a guide for students' targeted practice.

### Introducing the Blends & Digraphs Desktop Pocket Chart Card Set

Prepare the Desktop Pocket Chart ahead of time so that it stands up on your table or work area. Start by placing the Sound Position Cards in the bottom row of pockets. Next, select a few Photo Cards and their corresponding Blends & Digraphs Onset and Rime Letter Cards to work with. Place the chosen Photo Card in the first large pocket. Then, place the Letter Cards face up and within reach of students.

Explain to your group that they will be building a word using a picture to guide them. It is recommended that you start with the green letter cards set (blend and digraph/onset) and purple letter cards set (short vowel word endings/rime), then move to the orange letter cards set (long vowel word endings/rime) once students are ready.

For example, if you are using Photo Card #8, name the picture (twin), pronouncing each sound clearly and slowly (tw-in). Ask students to find the first sound they need to build the word (tw) amongst the green letter Cards, and place it in the beginning sound or onset position. Next, have students find the last sound they need to build the word (in) on the purple letter Cards, and place it in the ending or rime position. Read the word together, tracking each sound. Flip the Photo Card over and complete the same routine. Continue to practice building other words using the Photo Cards as guides.
